Turkmenistan: So much gas, so few customers

Turkmenistan has the world's fourth-largest gas reserves at 17.5 Tcm. But with Russia announcing in January that it would curb gas imports from Ashgabat and uncertainty over the volume of Turkmen gas exports to Iran, the Central Asian republic finds itself with only one, rather dominant customer – China.
