LNG SHIPPING: No East Africa LNG volumes forecasted until 2020

Seaborne LNG cargoes will hit 400 mtpa in 2020, but future volumes until then may not include any output from East Africa, speakers said at the Informa LNG Shipping event in London on Tuesday.

Presenting the above projections, Debbie Turner, senior shipping advisor at Simpson Spence & Young Shipbrokers, said the figures included projects that have reached a final investment decision (FID) and one expected project in Iran, but no volumes from East Africa.
