SoCalGas makes first withdrawal from Aliso Canyon since leak

Sempra Energy subsidiary Southern California Gas (SoCalGas) has withdrawn gas from its Aliso Canyon gas storage facility for the first time since January 2016 due to growing demand driven by cold weather.

Withdrawals will only utilise wells approved by state energy authorities, the company said. SoCalGas had requested permission to resume injections on a limited basis at Aliso Canyon in November.
