Engie fires up Bravo wellhead at giant Cygnus gas field in UK North Sea

Engie has produced first gas from a secondary well at the Cygnus gas complex, claimed to be the UK's largest single producing gas field in the North Sea.

The French utility's local upstream arm, Engie E&P UK, said gas from the unmanned Bravo wellhead platform was piped to the nearby Alpha processing unit, located 150 km off the coast of Lincolnshire in the Southern North Sea.

First gas was delivered from well B5 on ...
