Greka scores Chinese drilling contracts as Beijing pursues shale auctions

Asia-focused unconventional oil and gas driller Greka Drilling has been awarded two new drilling contracts by PetroChina for the Fanzhuang and Anze coalbed methane blocks located within Shanxi province, in the north of China.

Greka, a subsidiary of Green Dragon- the largest independent producer and distributor of coalbed methane in China – has been awarded a year-long contract for Fanzhuang, under which the company has been tasked with drilling 16 wells. The wells will consist of both exploration and production wells, Greka added.
